Through her work as an apothecary Giulia sold cure-alls and cosmetics to women from all walks of life. However to a select clientele she provided a secret product only available on referral.

Aqua Tofana: a colourless, odourless poison undetectable by the science of the time and easily slipped into an unsuspecting husband's drink. With a reported 600 victims to her name, Giulia Tofana is considered one of the most prolific serial killers of all time. But was she a hero or a villain?

Sat at a crossroads between right and wrong this teaser production examines the injustices of patriarchy as well as themes of class, misogyny and female empowerment.
